



Home Now—Discharge Check List



1. Preparation

Ideally, before your loved ones are discharged we would complete our preparation checklist. If discharge is imminent we can always follow through as we complete the on-the-day program.

1.1 In-Home Care Services Are Set Up And Scheduled

1.2 Home Safety Inspection And Home Modifications
